MCSPCA receives no federal or state financial assistance, and is not affiliated with nor do we receive financial support from the ASPCA. We rely primarily upon the generosity of people like you to save lives.

Making a Gift

Through a will or trust, you can bequeath a specific dollar amount, a percentage of your estate, or even all or part of the remainder of your estate. You can also bequeath specific assets including stocks, real estate, or other property. We are a 501(c)(3) charitable organization, and all contributions are tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law. The MCSPCA encourages you to contact your lawyer or financial planner before making any planned gift.

- Make a provision for the Monmouth County SPCA in your will or trust
- Designate the Monmouth County SPCA as a beneficiary of all or a portion of an insurance policy
- Designate the Monmouth County SPCA as the beneficiary of an IRA or other retirement plan

Sample Bequest Language:

I give and bequeath to the Monmouth County SPCA and Homeward Bound Adoption Center and/or Spay/Neuter Clinic of 260 Wall Street, Eatontown, NJ (the sum of _____) or (all or _____% of my residuary estate) for its general animal care purposes.

Providing for the Care of Surviving Pets:

- Please consider a gift of at least \$10,000 for each of your pets.
- Stipulate in your will that your surviving pets should be turned over to the Monmouth County SPCA and Homeward Bound Adoption Center of 260 Wall Street, Eatontown, NJ
- Your bequest should state that it should be used "...for its general purposes and for the care of my surviving pet(s) at the Monmouth County SPCA."
- We hope you will still make a provision to help other homeless animals should you have no pets surviving you.
- Please let us know if you have included care for your surviving pets at the MCSPCA in your estate plan!
